There are 13 different departments functioning in the college as per the regulations of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi. 60 bedded full-fledged hospital is attached with college which attracts patients from various parts of the world. In the hospital, there are 6 out-patient departments and 5 in-patient departments functioning. Separate hostels for boys and girls are maintained separately inside the college campus. Adjacent to college, very extensive herbal garden, encompasses more than 400 plant species and a drug manufacturing unit, manufactures around 300 Siddha medicines. College canteen caters homely and nutritious vegetarian food in the hygienic environment. Since the college is situated in the serene atmosphere of Santhigiri Ashram, the peaceful atmosphere provide suitable environment for study.

INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS

General

- 1. All students shall abide by existing rules and regulations of the college and hostel
- 2. Attainment of excellence in academic and clinical shall be our prime objective
- 3. Academic calendar ensures 255 working days & projects one year academic plan.
- 4. All academic related activities/events will be conducted as per the calendar. If the institution is not in a position to conduct any particular event due to unforeseen reasons as per the calendar or any changes in events, the same will be intimated by Principal's office through circular/order/notice/oral communication. This calendar is subjected to changes as decided by the Principal.
- 5. Extra holidays will be compensated.
- It is the duty of student to check the notice board daily for official notifications.
 College Timing
- 7. Student should be punctual and should be in the college during college hours (9am to 4pm). Lunch break- 12 noon to 1 pm.
- 8. Students should not leave the college premises during class hours without written permission of concerned subject handling teacher, class in charge and Principal; out-pass slip shall be obtained from college office.
- 9. Late comers will be penalized with Rs. 100/.
- 10. Inmates of hostels (Gents and Ladies) shall not be allowed to stay in the hostel during class hours without the written permission of concerned Classin-charge, Deputy warden, Assistant Convener and Warden (Principal)
- 11. Library timings: 9.00 am to 5.00 pm. Payable net facility is available. Students should strictly follow Library rules and regulations when inside the Library

Discipline

- 12. Students should not loiter in the corridors or speak loudly in front of the class room, library, hospital and office
- 13. The college premises and class rooms shall be kept clean. If the class rooms found with writings on the wall and damaged, such damages are liable for common fine for the students of the concerned class.
- 14. Smoking, consumption of pan and liquor is strictly prohibited and punishable
- 15. Students should not hold any meetings or collect money from any other students without proper permission of the Class-in-charge/ HOD, or Principal
- 16. Mobile phone, camera, I-pod, tab and other electronic devices are not allowed inside the class/ college/hospital/ hostel. If found, a fine of Rs 5000/- will be collected from the student and the device will not be returned further.

- 21. White& white dress is compulsory for boys and girls on Thursdays.

22. Failing which (19,20,21) the student will be liable for the fine Rs 100/- at the first time, Rs 200/- at the second time and Rs 300/- thereafter

Tuition Fees/ Hostel fees/ Mess Fees

- 23. College tuition fee and hostel fee shall be paid in the month of September/October every year.i.e. commencement of new academic year
- 24. Mess fee shall be remitted every month in between 25 to 30/31st to avail food for the coming month.

<u>Leave</u>

- 25. Unauthorized leave will not be entertained and such cases will be penalized Rs 100/- per day to attend the classes further.
- 26. Routing system of leave application: Leave application of the students of preclinical batches (I and II Prof.) shall be routed through concerned subject handling Teaching faculties, Class-in-Charge, Vice Principal (Academic) to the Principal. Students of clinical batches (III and Final Professional) shall apply through concerned subject handling Faculties, Class-in-Charge, Vice Principal (Academic & Clinical) to the Principal. All leave applications must be addressed to the Principal.
- 27. If not possible in certain circumstances or emergencies, the reason for the leave shall be intimated to Class-in-Charges over the phone and he/ she shall submit leave request for the period of absence through proper channel, after coming to the college.

Attendance:

28.80% of attendance is mandatory for each subject (theory and Practical/ clinical separately) for appearing university examinations.

Internal Assessment (IA) Examinations/ Progress Report:

- 29.IA and Progress report: IA examinations shall be conducted during the prescribed period in the academic calendar. Exam time table will be notified by the Principal's office before concerned examinations.
- 30. Totally three IA examinations will be conducted in each professional session. Acquiring 35% of IA marks is mandatory to become eligible for appearing university examinations. Students shall attend all IA examinations (Theory & Practical/Clinical) as per the schedule without fail.
- 31. Progress report with IA marks and attendance will be dispatched to the parents immediately after completion of each IA examination by the Class-in-Charge and College office.

Extra Classes

32. If necessary, extra classes/ remedial classes will be conducted in between 4 pm to 5 pm or on Saturdays afternoon with the prior permission of the Principal.

Practical and Clinical Records of the Students

33. It is compulsory for the students to write the record and get the sign of the concerned faculty within 2-3 days after completion of each practical/clinical. It is the responsibility of the student to get the sign of HOD before the commencement of university theory examinations. No record will be signed after the period as specified here.

University Examinations

34. The schedule of university examinations will be put on the notice board

- 35. It is mandatory to acquire minimum 80% of the attendance and minimum 35% of IA marks in each subject (theory and practical/ clinical separately) to become eligible for appearing university examinations.
- 36. Fifteen days- study holidays will be given before the commencement of university regular examinations. Concerned Class-in-Charge will take initiative in this regard.
- 37. After completion of University examinations (Theory & Practical), maximum 7 days leave will be given before entering into next professional session. Concerned class-in-charge will take steps in this regard.

Educational Tour

- 38. Educational tour will be permitted only during prescribed month in the calendar; Because that period is found to be free from examinations, rigorous academic activities and other commitments.
- 39. Permitted tour days: (I Prof BSMS 2 days, II Prof BSMS 2 days, III Prof BSMS 3 days, Final Prof. BSMS- 5 days)
- 40. Conducting tour every year by a batch is not a compulsory one: purely optional

Extra/ Co curricular activities

- 41. Extra/Co curricular activities will be organized by concerned Committee/Club as per the calendar.
- 42. Request for the conduct of all such activities of N.S.S, Fine Arts Committee, Science Club, Sports Committee, Bhoomitra Club etc. shall be routed through Head of the committee concerned, Vice Principal (Academic) to the Principal **Routing Mechanism:**
- 43. All college academic communications/proceedings shall be routed through Vice Principal (Academic) to Principal and all clinical/hospital communications/ proceedings through Vice principal (Clinical) to Principal

Updating of Contact Details in Official Records

44. It is the duty of the student to update contact details including permanent address, landline number, mobile number (of father, mother, local guardian -if any and the student) and mail ID (of father and the student) in the college office.

INSTRUCTIONS/ GUIDELINES TO TEACHING FACULTIES

<u>General</u>

- 1. Please read the "Instructions and Guidelines" to the students.
- 2. Academic calendar ensures 255 working days and projects one year academic plan.
- 3. All academic related activities/events shall be conducted as per the calendar. If the institution is not in a position to conduct any event as per the calendar or any changes in the events due to unforeseen reasons, the same will be intimated by Principal's office through circular/order/notice/oral communication. This calendar is subjected to changes as decided by the Principal
- 4. Extra holidays will be compensated.
- 5. Faculties shall check the notice board daily for official notifications.
- 6. Principal office information/communication system: Circular/ Notice/ Order/ Oral/ Mobile messages.

College/ Class Timings

- 7. College timings: 09-00 am to 04-00 pm. Teaching faculties should put their sign in the attendance register at 09 am in the morning and 04 pm in the evening and mark in the "Aadhaar and GPS linked biometric attendance system" without fail.
- 8. HOD's shall ensure that the teaching faculties, and non teaching staff of their department are punctual and attentive in their duties
- 9. Staff should be in the college/department during college hours (9am to 4pm). If a staff leaves the college campus in working hours with the permission of the HOD and Principal, that shall be marked in the movement register in the college office.
- 10. Teachers shall start and finish their class sharply in their allotted hour. Coming late to class and dragging the class to next hour without intimating the concerned teaching faculty, shall be avoided.
- 11. Taking extra classes after 5 pm in the evening shall not be allowed

Discipline

- 12. It is the prime duty of HOD's, Class-in-Charge and Teaching faculties to monitor the discipline (punctuality, neatness, dress code, code of behavior/conduct etc) of the students.
- 13. Discipline related issues of the students in the college shall be reported to the Principal through HOD, Vice Principal (Academic) and in the hospital side through HOD, Vice Principal (Clinical) for further actions and the same has to be intimated to the concerned Class-in-Charge

Dress Code

14. White dress is compulsory for the faculties and students on Thursdays.

Tuition Fees/ Hostel Fees/ Mess Fees

15. Students shall pay tuition fee during September/October, every year. Class-in-Charges shall remind and insist the students to pay the fee within the prescribed time to avoid further consequences.

<u>Leave</u>

- 16. Leave application of teaching staff should be routed through concerned HOD, Vice Principal (Academic) to the Principal; Clinical staff should be routed through Vice Principal (Academic), Vice Principal (Clinical) to the Principal.
- 17. Faculty those who are going on leave, he/she has to make alternate duty arrangement and the same has to be mentioned in leave application with concerned faculty's sign.
- 18. Extension of leave or leave on emergencies or leave due to unforeseen reasons should be intimated to the Principal/ Vice Principal (Academic)/Vice Principal (Clinical)/ Assistant Convener over the phone before 09 am and produce leave request in written immediately after returning to the college.
- 19. Leave application of non teaching staff, working in the department shall be routed through concerned HOD to the Assistant Convener.
- 20. Faculties performing duty in the hospital/college during holidays as per the Principal's official order, can credit leave in the compensatory- off register. Comp. off request connected with hospital duty has to be forwarded through Vice Principal (Clinical) and college duty (if any) through Vice Principal (Academic) to the Principal.

Internal Assessment (IA) Examinations/ Progress Report

- 21.IA and Progress report: IA examinations shall be conducted as per the calendar.
- 22. Class-in-charge should prepare the time table/schedule by consulting with concerned HOD's/subject handling teachers. Approved time table/ schedule to be notified at least one week prior to the examination.
- 23. There shall be three IA examinations in each professional session for theory and practical (including viva) separately, out of which final one will be university model exam and it is mandatory.
- 24. Average marks of the best two IA examinations shall be taken as IA marks for the candidate. Acquiring minimum 35% of IA marks is mandatory to become eligible for appearing university examinations.
- 25. The class average of IA marks of theory and practical (separately) should not exceed 75% of maximum marks
- 26. All faculties shall hand over IA marks and attendance in a prescribed format to the Class –in- charge within 7 days from the last date of each IA exam so as to complete the progress report work by the class-in-charge probably on 10th day. Progress report with IA marks and attendance shall be dispatched from the office to the parents probably on 11th day.
- 27. Parents teachers meet should be arranged by concerned Class-in-charge within a month after completion of IA examination. The date of meet to be informed to the parents in the progress report itself and also through mobile bulk message system from the office.
- 28. Model university exams (Final IA exam) shall be completed one month before the date of commencement of University exam. Concerned class –in –charge shall collect IA marks and Attendance in each subject, one month before the commencement of university examination for uploading in KUHS site during exam registration.

Term wise portions, Extra classes, Revision Classes and Remedial classes

- 29. It is the duty of Class-in-charge to hand over term wise portion (slot) in each subject of the concerned year to the Principal through Vice Principal (Academic) in the month of September every year.
- 30. Teaching faculties shall complete term wise portion in their subjects within committed period.
- 31. If necessary, extra classes can be conducted in between 4 pm to 5 pm or on Saturdays afternoon (1pm to 3pm) with the prior permission of Principal in the prescribed format. Attendance to be maintained for extra classes.
- 32. Revision classes shall be conducted minimum for 10 days before the commencement of study holidays.
- 33. Remedial classes have to be conducted for weak students **Practical and Clinical Records of the Students**
- 34. It is compulsory for the students to write the record and get the sign of the concerned faculty within 2-3 days after the completion of each practical/ clinical. It is the responsibility of the student to get the sign of HOD before university theory examinations.

University Examinations

- 35. University exam will be notified and registration process will get started exactly one month before the university examination. At the time of exam registration, Class-in-charges shall upload IA marks and attendance of students for all subjects in the university site in the presence of concerned subject handling faculty.
- 36. Faculty shall get the signature of students in the generated statement of IA marks and Attendance
- 37. It is mandatory for the student to acquire minimum 80% of the attendance and minimum 35% of IA marks in each subject (theory and practical/ clinical separately) to become eligible for appearing university examinations.
- 38. The schedule of university examinations will be displayed on the notice board. For theory and practical examinations, class-in-charges shall prepare the list of invigilators and skilled experts by consulting with concerned faculties, and produce to Principal through Vice Principal(Academic) and in case of clinical examinations it should forward through Vice Principal (Clinical) at least 10 days before the commencement of University theory/practical/clinical examinations.
- 39. Maximum fifteen days study holidays will be provided before the commencement of university regular examinations. Concerned class-in-charge should take necessary steps in this regard at appropriate time.
- 40. Theory valuation: Double valuation of the answer books shall be done by qualified examiners duly appointed by KUHS. The average of marks obtained for double valuation of each paper is taken as the final mark of the student in that subject/paper.
- 41. Third valuation: If the variation in total marks obtained in two valuations is more than 15% of the total marks and the marks obtained in any one of the valuation is more than 35% of the total marks, the answer book shall undergo a third valuation in that subject/paper. In such cases, average of highest two marks among three valuations shall be taken as final mark.
- 42.No revaluation; Re-totaling only be permitted on submission of application to the university along with the prescribed fees within the period notified by KUHS

- 43. There is a provision at university for obtaining Photostat copies of theory answer books and theory score sheets on submission of application along with the prescribed fees by the candidate. This provision is not applicable for practical including viva examinations
- 44. Moderation of maximum 5 marks are applicable for a subject(or subjects) including practical.
- 45. Student shall clear all the subjects of previous years before registering for Final Professional BSMS examinations
- 46. Course period allotted for the student: Double the course period. i.e. He/She shall complete 4 ½ course period within maximum 9 years. Otherwise the student will be terminated from the course.
- 47. After completion of University examination (Theory & Practical), maximum 7 days leave will be given to the particular batch before entering into next professional session. Such order will be issued in time and concerned class-in-charge shall take the steps.

Updating of Contact Details of Students In Official Records

48. Class-in-charge shall take initiation to collect contact details of the students in the given format for official records during the commencement of new professional session and hand over to Principal's office. Forms will be issued from the office.

Department Maintenance

- 49. Teaching faculties of each department shall furnish the details of number of theory and practical/ clinical class conducted and the list of seminars and other activities conducted in their subject during the calendar year (January to December) on 31st of December to Principal through Vice Principal (Academic)
- 50. Teaching faculties shall also produce the details to the Principal through Vice Principal (Academic) on 31st of December about the total number of books available in the departmental library and charts/flex, specimens, models kept in their department
- 51. Maintenance of "topic taught register" by teaching faculty is mandatory and it should be duly signed by the Principal once in a month
- 52. Each department should maintain batch wise time table, department stock register, attendance register of the students (theory and practical/ clinical separately) properly. Attendance register should be duly certified and signed by HOD and Head of the institution.
- 53. Dept. shall maintain "Department-Library" and Museum (if specified)
- 54. Department should keep a copy of study/ teaching materials/ modules, and model of practical/clinical record
- 55. HOD's shall ensure the availability of instruments, equipments, chemical and reagents etc in the department as per the Minimum Standard Regulations prescribed by CCIM.

Teaching Methods

- 56. Faculties should use all available teaching aids and can introduce innovative teaching methods to make their classes more effective
- 57. Teaching faculties should encourage peer teaching, cross teaching and micro teaching to build the student's presentation/ teaching/ learning/ communication skills.

Meetings

- 58. College council/Academic Committee (consisting of Principal, Professors and HOD's) meeting to be convened as and when necessary by the Principal.
- 59. Staff meeting (as and when required), Class-in-charges meeting (monthly), Year-wise faculty meeting (once in 3 months esp. after each IA examination) will be convened by Vice Principal (Academic) under the chairmanship of Principal.
- 60. Clinical staff meeting will be convened by Vice Principal (Clinical) under the chairmanship of Principal as and when required
- 61. Non-teaching staff (office staff/ non- teaching staff/ hostel staff) meeting will be convened by Assistant Convener under the chairmanship of Principal.
- 62. Hostel meetings will be convened by concerned Deputy Wardens for hostel staff and inmates minimum once in a month.

Club activities, NSS and Bhoomitrasena
